

How it's created a gardening explosion







Quarantine restrictions have increased the popularity of at home gardening

- Offers calm and comfort
- Being outdoors in nature is freeing
- Nurturing and cultivating plants eases tensions when things feel beyond your control
- Teaches children the importance of horticulture
- Provides a fresh food supply






Some examples of its growing popularity come from *The Washington Post*:

- Baker Creek Heirloom Seeds in Mansfield, MO said that orders had doubled to 4,500 daily – shut down their website for three days to catch up on orders
- Kitchen Garden Seeds estimates that sales are up 40% YOY







Novice gardeners armed with packs of seeds understandably struggle with:

- Propagation practices

Many new gardeners are young

- In a 2019 Gardening Survey, Millennials comprised 30% of gardening households and continue to out-pace older age groups
- Health and wellness are important to the Millennial generation
- However, Millennials share of the US housing market was just 4% in 2019 and is trending down
 - Student loans and other debt is cited as the reason





With homeownership declining in this high gardening growth area:

- Container and patio gardens are now a popular alternative for small spaces (apartment living)
- *The Daily Green* states that "U.S. consumers now spend \$1.3 billion dollars on container gardening"
- Container gardens are less demanding on people's schedules, often viewed as decorative elements, produce quick results, temporary





How can you contribute to the market?


- Gardening starter kits with propagation trays, finished pots, soil amendments and care instructions

More desire for sustainable offerings









In a recent survey conducted by Kearney Consultants, participants were asked if their attitude towards environmental practices had changed due to COVID-19









- **48%** said the pandemic had made them more concerned about the environment
- 55% said that as a result of their COVID-19 experiences they were "more likely to purchase environmentally friendly products"
- 78% of consumers now believe that companies could be doing more to help them make decisions that improve environmental outcomes


Progression Planter and Hanging Basket
